YES! You may line your 13 Gallon Bin with a paper lawn & leaf bags! (And also have extra for lawn items and organics over-flow, kitty litter, etc...).

YES! You may use regular paper bags from the grocery store!

YES! You may choose to line your bin with NOTHING!

YES! You may use Compostable bags for ANY of your bins.... HOWEVER!

Compostable Bags MUST be BPI Approved!
